

Front View




Hardware Installation

Please follow the steps below to install the RocketAIC 7749EW into a motherboard with a compatible PCIe slot.

- Disconnect all power and powered devices from your system.
 Open the motherboard chassis cover.
- 2. Insert the RocketAIC 7749EW into an available PCIe slot.
- Once the RocketAIC 7749EW is fully seated affix the included screw to the bracket.
- 4. Reassemble the chassis cover and reconnect the system to the power supply.

Note: n case the motherboard PCIe slot has insufficient power, connect the 6-pin PCIe power cable to the external power connector on the right side of the RocketAIC 7749EW before turning on the system's power.
